- Find your FAFSA information or contact the financial/ business office at school to request a note indicating you qualify for FAFSA. We do not need to know the figures, just a *yes* or *no*.
- Contact the people you are requesting recommendations from. Let them know you will need it **ASAP**
- Begin working on your first draft of your essay.
- Secure official transcripts.
- Continue revisions and finalize your essay
- Review packet that all components are in the envelope before sealing and mailing.

At that time the recipient will be introduced and will share his/her personal essay. either in person or video depending on COVID recommendations at the time. The essay will be published in the Bulalakaw. and/or the FAAWIS website.
